This book is intended to provide assistance at the bedside or in the consultation room. To this end, the author has refrained from detailed discussion of anatomical or physiological aspects and lengthy considerations of treatment. At the beginning of each chapter the principal diagnoses that have to be taken into consideration are listed. This list, with numbered items corresponding to the sequence of items in the text, will immediately give the reader an idea of the challenge he has to meet in a given situation. For each diagnostic possibility the pros and cons are then discussed, and the potential contribution of ancillary examinations is evaluated. Extensive cross-referencing is intended to facilitate comparison with similar situations or patterns of findings.

Modern views on the importance and selection of animal models in brain aging research are discussed. These contributions to the aging brain present the latest efforts by neuroscientists to tackle the problem of brain disorders.

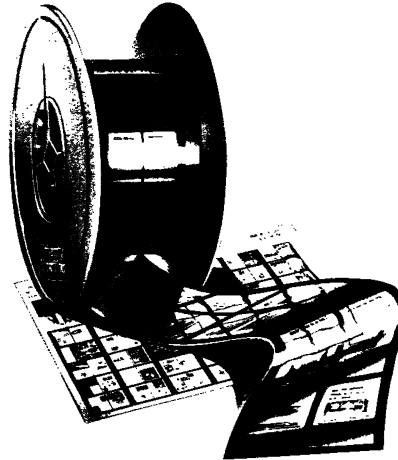

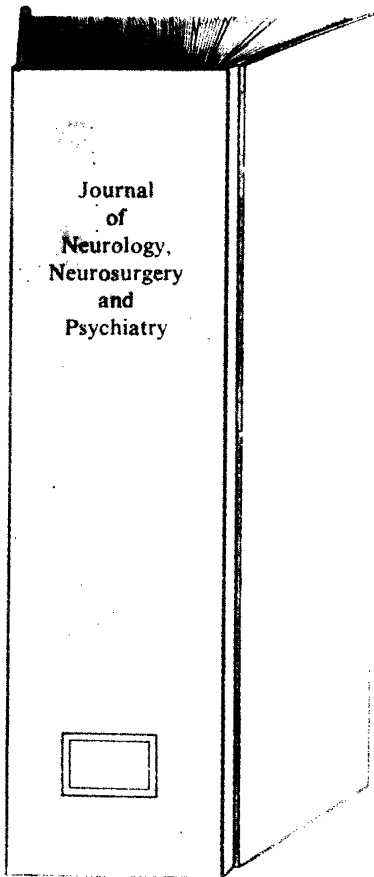
