

## ADDENDUM

At one year follow-up, patient 2, who had shown improvement, now has a rating score of 48 (a deterioration of 21 points) and his weight has dropped to 6st. 6lb., a change of —2st. 6lb., following an episode of pneumonia. One must conclude, therefore, that penicillamine in this case has brought at best a temporary improvement only in the patient's condition.
